FIELD VISIT: SITE 2

**Location**: Goad Family Farm, 2987 Chillinup Rd (google maps pin = bit.ly/clayscf)

**Description**: SCF have started a new project investment with the GRDC to improve the Clay spreading efficiency in the local area. SCF members are well aware of the benefits of applying Clay to their sandy duplex soils. However, the methods of determining the amount of Clay required to successfully ameliorate each paddock are ad-hoc and based on guesswork. Therefore, there is a high risk of under or over-applying Clay, which is both inefficient and potentially ineffective. Daniel Fay and Nathan Dovey will explain the key factors a grower needs to know to determine how much Clay they should be applying to their soil. Additionally, Josh and Tony Goad will show us their new machine for spreading Clay made locally by NuFab in Western Australia.
