CONICAL SNAIL DISSECTION WORKSHOPS FOR GROWERS & ADVISERS

Stirlings to Coast Farmers (SCF) and South East Premium Wheat Growers Association (SEPWA), with investment from GRDC, are hosting snail dissection workshops in the Albany and Esperance regions. The aim of the project is to upskill people (advisers and local farmers) across the South Coast to:

- Dissect snails to determine their reproductive status (are they getting ready to lay eggs?!)
- Contribute the data they collect into a widely available alert map for the South Coast so that baiting can be timely and effective.

Growers and advisers are encouraged to attend and if you opt to continue to be part of the program, you will be equipped with your own microscope (for keeps), snail dissection gear and you will be paid for your time (up to \$1200).
